Are You Prepared?

As summer begins to wind down, and fall approaches we just want to make sure, you are a prepared for the upcoming season. A few key things to remember:

1. Traffic-beginning in September will become horrendous especially for you commuters. Remember to give yourself extra time whether you are driving or taking the bus.
2. To arrange for proper babysitters (if you have children) make sure you have a back up always ready in case of emergency.
3. Dress accordingly. The days will be warm but the evenings will get cool. If you work in the evenings, make sure you stay warm. Be prepared for weather changes with umbrellas and proper waterproof footwear with good grips.

Administration of Oral Medications

From Dosette or Bubble Pack

1. Explain procedure to client
2. Wash hands
3. Obtain bubble pack or dosette container. If bubble pack, check for client's name. I.E. Monday 9am
4. Select right date and time on container
5. Punch out or remove pills from container, placing them on a small plate. (don't touch them)
6. Take medications to client with a drink
7. Watch while client takes medications
8. Return bubble pack or dosette to where it is stored
9. Document (notify office or on call supervisor if meds are out of order, meds missing from dossett, or client having difficulty adhering to a schedule)

If you have any problems make sure you call the office for direction. And remember you must speak to one of the RN's if you have never done this task on this specific client before.

Assignable, Certified, Trained to complete the Task 2's included in this program (medications, catheter care, colostomy care) without further direct or indirect training from the Field Supervisors prior to completing these tasks.

The schedules for the classes will be placed on the bulletin board in the office, so sign up asap to get the choice you want.
